Setup

Serato software

The AlphaTheta OMNIS-DUO is a "Serato DJ Lite hardware unlocked" device, meaning it works with Serato DJ Lite out of the box.

It is also a "paid upgrade to Serato DJ Pro device", meaning it requires the purchase & activation of a Serato DJ Pro license, in order to be used with Serato DJ Pro.

Drivers

The AlphaTheta OMNIS-DUO is class compliant on macOS, but requires manufacturer specific drivers when used with Windows operating systems.

Regardless of your operating system, download and install the latest version of Serato DJ Pro, then connect your OMNIS-DUO with a USB cable to your computer, and launch Serato DJ Pro.

If using Windows, when prompted, click the **Install Driver** pop-up.



Connection


Connect your OMNIS-DUO with a USB cable to your computer & launch Serato DJ Pro, and follow the prompts below, on the OMNIS-DUO touch-screen display:

- 1. Touch [SOURCE]
- 2. Touch [SOFTWARE CONTROL]
- 3. Touch [LOAD 1] to connect deck 1
- 4. Touch [LOAD 2] to connect deck 2

1	USB-C POWER INPUT	Connect the included USB-C power adapter to a power source	
2	USB-A SOURCE	Connect USB storage device for standalone usage or firmware update	
3	USB-C PC	Connect USB cable to PC	
4	KENSINGTON LOCK	Secure device	
5	MASTER 1	Main audio output via XLR	
6	BOOTH MASTER 2	Connect Booth output via balanced TRS	
7	MIC 2	Connect microphone input via balanced XLR or TRS, and control microphone input attenuation	
8	MIC 1	Connect microphone input via balanced TRS, and control microphone input attenuation	
9	PHONES	Connect headphones via 3.5mm or 6.5mm jack

16	COLOR FX	Turn the respective channel's Color FX Filter knob left or right to apply the effect	-
17	BEAT FX (SECTION)	Beat FX Left & Right increase or decrease multiplier, turning Beat FX Depth right adjusts effect, and Beat FX On / Off toggles Beat FX on and off	Press Beat FX Left to set auto BPM value for Beat FX, and press Beat FX Right repeteadly to manually set Beat FX tempo

19	CHANNEL FADER	Adjust channel volume (per channel)	Channel fader start (per channel)
20	CROSSFADER	Crossfade audio between channel 1-2	-
21	HEADPHONES (SECTION)	Toggle channel cue for channel 1 / 2, adjust headphone cue / master mix and adjust headphone level	-
22	EQ (SECTION)	Adjust channel EQ (Hi, Mid, Low)	-
23	PLAY / PAUSE	Toggles Play / Pause on selected deck	Stutter play
24	CUE	Cues from temp cue point/Set temp cue point	Load previous track
25	SHIFT	Shift modifier, which can be held while using another control for secondary SHIFT function	-
26	(MIC) ON	Turn microphone on/off	Talkover



MIDI

The MIDI feature in Serato DJ Pro provides the ability to remap Serato DJ Pro software functions to your primary Serato controller, interface or mixer. You can also assign controls to a secondary MIDI controller to further enhance your performance.

To remap your supported Serato device, open the SETUP screen and click the MIDI tab. If your Serato device supports hardware remapping, it will show up in the MIDI Devices list at the top.

Select your connected device from the MIDI Devices list and make sure the "Allow Serato Hardware Remapping" option is checked.

Allow Serato Hardware Remapping

Once checked, the MIDI assign button at the top of the screen will become available for you to start remapping.

You can save, edit or delete MIDI presets in the MIDI tab of the SETUP screen. Clicking 'Restore Defaults' will erase any custom mappings for all connected devices and revert their functions back to default.

Help

Show Tooltips

Click on the Holp button in the upper right-hand corner of Serato DJ Pro, then to enable tooltips. Tool tips provide a handy way to learn the various features of Serato DJ Pro.

Move the mouse over a section of the screen to bring up a context sensitive tool tip.

Watch Tutorials

Click on the button in the upper right-hand corner of Serato DJ Pro, then watch tutorials to launch your default internet browser and watch tutorials, to help you get familiar with Serato DJ Pro.

Get Support

Click on the Holp button in the upper right-hand corner of Serato DJ Pro, then Get support to launch your default internet browser and navigate to the Serato DJ Pro knowledge base, where you can find helpful articles and guides on Serato DJ Pro. Alternatively, type in the Search help Go box, with keywords, to search the Serato DJ Pro knowledge base for specific, related topics.
