Installation and Setup

The Pioneer DDJ-WeGO 3 is a class compliant USB plug and play device for Mac, however requires drivers for Windows. You will find these on the installation cd provided with your Pioneer DDJ-WeGO 3.

NOTE: Please ensure you have the latest available drivers AND firmware updates, which may be required in order to be compatible with Serato DJ. Please go to <http://serato.com/dj/support>

1. Download and Install the latest version of Serato DJ from <http://serato.com/dj/downloads>
2. Connect your Pioneer DDJ-WeGO 3 to an available USB Port. Open Serato DJ.

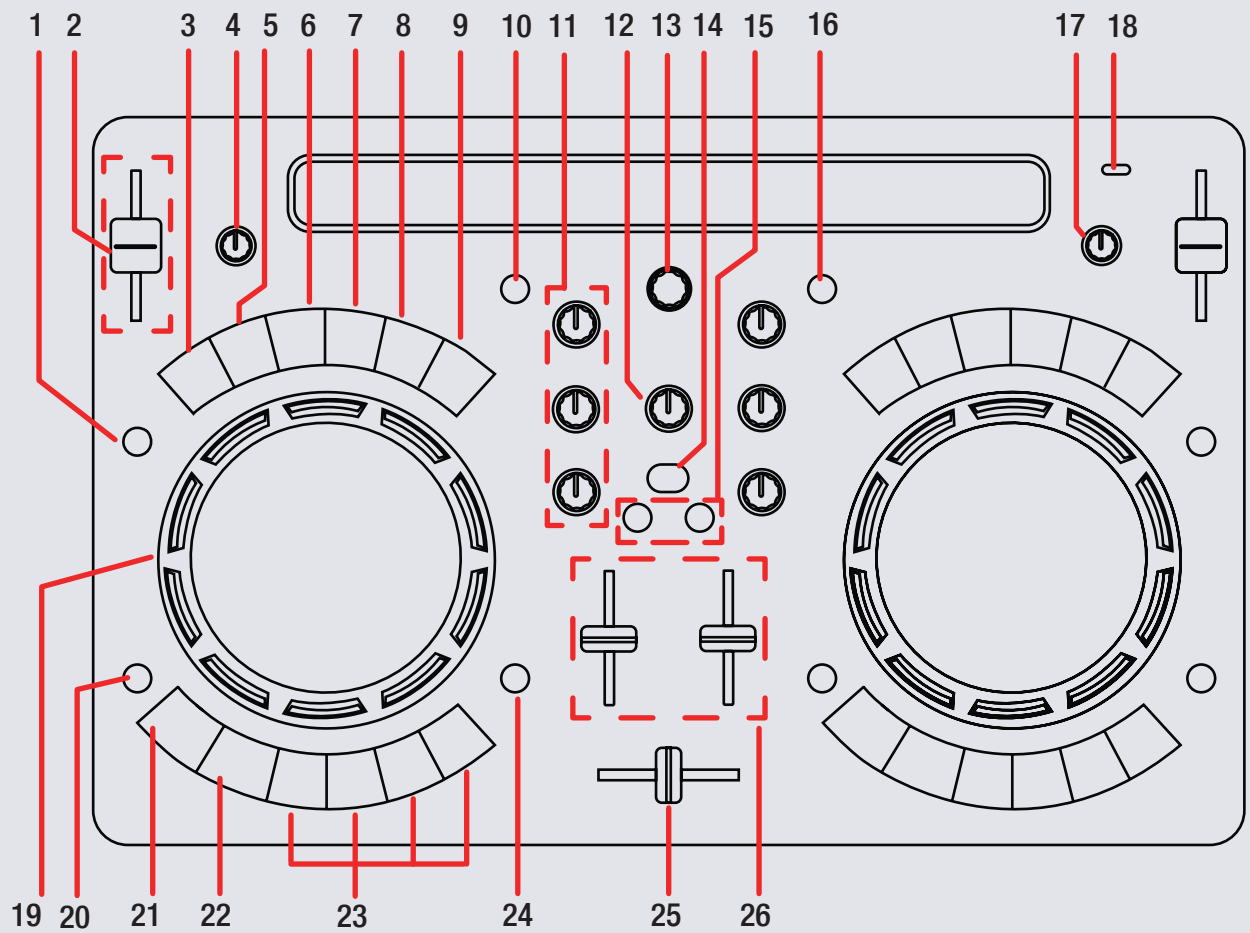

1	SYNC	Turn SYNC on	Sync Off (Press twice to return to Absolute Pitch)
2	TEMPO FADER	Adjust Tempo	When in Sync mode, used to disable the Pitch Fader temporarily and change the zero position
3	1/2X	Halves the current loop size	Set Manual Loop In point (Adjust In point if loop is active)
4	MIC VOL	Adds and triggers Cue Points/Triggers Sampler Slots	Delete Cue Points/Stop Sampler Slots
5	LOOP	Turn Auto Loop On	Loop Off/Reloop
6	2X	Doubles the current loop size	Set Manual Loop Out point (Adjust Out point if loop is active)
7	FX 1	Enables Jog FX 1	Select Effect in Slot 1
8	FX 2	Enables Jog FX 2 / Adjust FX modifier	Select Effect in Slot 2 (Multi-FX only)
9	FX 3	Enables Jog FX 3 / Adjust FX modifier	Select Effect in Slot 3 (Multi-FX only)
10	LOAD A	Load selected track to deck B	
11	CHANNEL EQ	Adjust HI, MID and LOW	
12	HEADPHONE VOL	Adjust headphone output	
13	BROWSE	Browse songs in library or crate view. Press to toggle BACK	
14	CUE SELECT	Cue master output in headphones	
15	CUE A/B	Cue selected channel in headphones	
16	LOAD B	Load selected track to deck B	
17	MASTER VOL	Adjust Master output volume

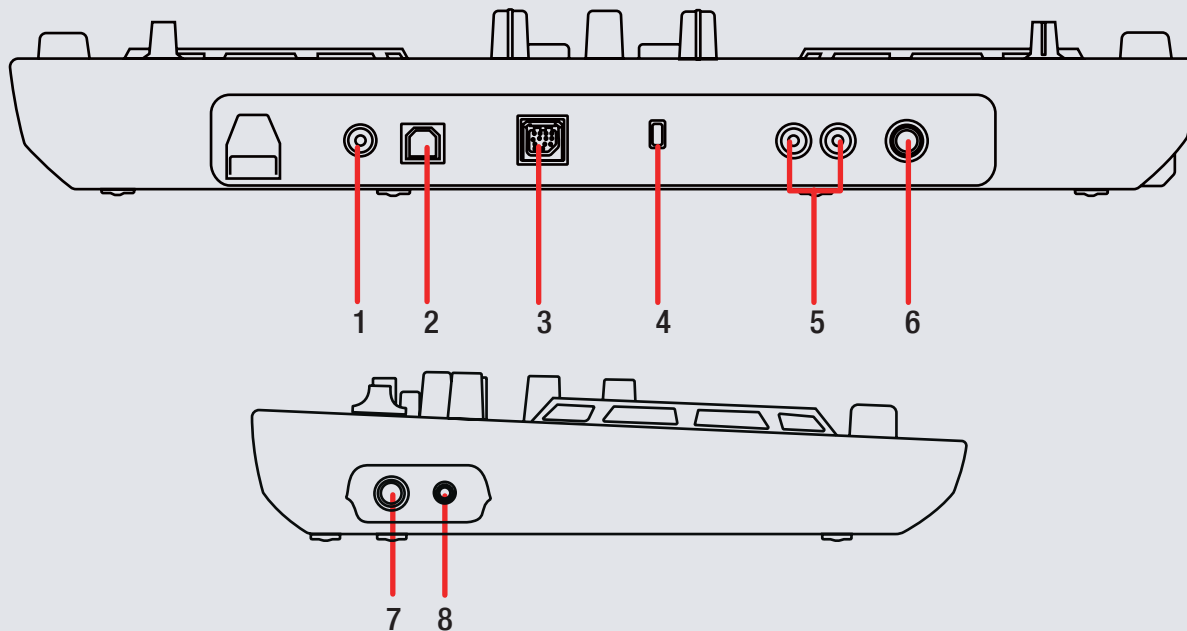

17	MASTER VOL	Adjust Master output volume	
18	STANDBY/ON	WeGo 3 Power On/Standby	
19	JOG WHEEL	Touch the top to scratch. Moving the outside of the wheel will bend pitch of your track.	Beat skip
20	SHIFT	Used with other controls that have SHIFT modifier functions	
21	CUE	Play from Temp Cue/Set temp Cue	Load previous track in library
22	PLAY/PAUSE	Play or pause the playing track	
23	CUE POINTS	Add or trigger Hot Cues/Triggers samples in Sampler mode.	Delete cue point/Stops playing samples.
24	HOT CUE/SAMPLER	Toggle between Hot Cues and Sampler	
25	CROSSFADER	Crossfade audio from Channel A to Channel B	
26	CHANNEL FADER	Adjust Channel Volume

#	DDJ-WeGO 3	Function
1	DC POWER IN	DC power input
2	USB	Connect WeGo 3 to your computer via USB
3	iOS DOCK	Connect WeGo 3 to your iOS device (no function with Serato DJ)
4	KENSINGTON LOCK	Lock the controller using a Kensington Lock
5	RCA MASTER OUT	RCA connections for master output
6	MIC	Microphone input
7	1/4" HEADPHONES	Connect 1/4" headphones to this output
8	1/8" HEADPHONES	Connect 1/8" headphones to this output

Looping

You have the choice of Auto or Manual Looping within Serato DJ with the Pioneer DDJ-WeGo 3.


Looping is controlled by the AUTO LOOP/MANUAL buttons for each deck. Manual Looping is controlled by holding **SHIFT** and pressing a loop button control.

DDJ-WeGO 3 Control	Auto Loop	Manual Loop
LOOP	Auto Loop On/Off	Loop Off/ReLoop
1/2X	Half Loop Length	Set/Adjust Loop In point
2X	Double Loop Length	Set/Adjust Loop Out point



NOTE You can also save a loop to the next available free loop slot in the software. To do this, click  on an available loop slot. Your loops are saved to the file and recalled the next time it is loaded. They are not lost if the file is moved or renamed.

DJ-FX

The DJ-FX in Serato DJ are powered by iZotope™.

Click the FX tab  open the FX panel. Select either 1, 2 or M to assign the selected effect bank to a deck or Master Output.

There are two available FX modes. Single FX Mode allows you to select one effect per FX bank, and has multiple parameters that can be adjusted. Multi FX Mode allows you to select up to three effects per FX bank, and adjust only one parameter, the FX Depth. The same effects available in Single FX mode are available in Multi FX mode, as well some additional presets.

You can select between the two FX modes by clicking either the Single FX mode button  or Multi FX mode button .

FX 1	Slot 1 Effect On/Off and links platter to FX Parameter	Select Effect in Slot 1
FX 2	Slot 2 Effect On/Off and links platter to FX Parameter	Select Effect in Slot 2
FX 3	Slot 3 Effect On/Off and links platter to FX Parameter	Select Effect in Slot 3


MIDI

The MIDI control feature in Serato DJ provides the ability to map Serato DJ software functions to MIDI controller functions such as keyboards, triggers, sliders, and knobs. Integrating MIDI controllers into your Serato DJ setup can improve live performance usability, such as hitting pads on a MIDI controller to trigger Loops and Cue Points.

NOTE You can **not** MIDI Map your DDJ-WeGO 3, you will need to connect an additional MIDI controller to use these MIDI functions.

Using the Tool Tips

Click on the  icon to enable Tool Tips. This is located in between the MIDI and setup button in the top right hand corner of the screen. Tool Tips provide a handy way to learn the various features of Serato DJ.

Move the mouse over a section of the screen to bring up a context sensitive tool tip. Holding the mouse over the  button with Tool Tips turned on will show you a list of all keyboard shortcuts.
